Feedback Summary

School Development Plan

- Most participants surveyed reported that they learned about the school's School Development Plan through School Council Meetings and from SchoolMessenger emails.
- Most participants agreed that their child's learning can benefit from the goals, outcomes, actions, and resources outlined in the SDP.
- When asked whether the learning needs of all students are reflected and prioritized in the goals, outcomes, actions, and resources in the SDP, most participants indicated that this question was difficult to answer because they are not aware of the full range of student needs within the school.

School Budget and Fees

- When asked which activities and services are most important, all participants agreed that field trips, in-school programming with guest presenters, and residencies are valuable. Council members noted that they work hard to raise funds to support student opportunities. One participant wondered about raising and

contributing funds to support students who are unable to afford activities such as field trips, on-site activities etc.

- Most participants agreed that the activities provided by the school are important for their child's learning. Participants also reported that school fees are reasonable considering the benefits to their child.
- Most participants indicated that the opportunity for students to participate in Swimming lessons was a priority.
